NEW STUDENT FEE SCHEDULE -- 2018/2019

Please note that all tuition and fees are payable through Smart Tuition.

- **ENROLLMENT FEE:** \$150.00 - Payable at time of acceptance (after testing).
- **TESTING FEE:** \$50.00 - Payable at the time of testing.
- **BUILDING FUND FEE:** \$350.00 per student - Payable when the student is accepted. **Must be paid before student is officially enrolled.**
- **YEARLY START UP FEE:** \$350.00 - This fee is due in full by Friday, September 14, 2018. Reminders will be in the back-to-school email sent in July 2018. Please do not include in your tuition payment.
- **ATHLETIC FEE:** \$100.00 for each student per sport played with the exception of \$75.00 for B-Team volleyball & basketball, and \$25.00 for cheerleaders and skeet team members. This fee must be paid prior to participation for athletes in Grades 5 - 12.
- **WITHDRAWAL FEE:** \$100.00. Must be paid before records can be released.
- **RETURNED CHECK FEE:** \$35.00 per check returned for all returned checks.
- **CONVENIENCE FEE:** 2.85% of total charged for all debit/credit card transactions
- **FAILED ACH FEE:** \$30.00 per failed bank transfer through Smart Tuition.
- **LATE FEE:** Tuition is due by the 15th of each month. After the last day of each month each family account will incur a fee of \$40.00 payable to Smart Tuition for a late payer reminder.
- **TUITION FEE:**
 - Grades K3-K4: \$3,900 (\$325 per month for 12 payments)
 - Grades K5-7: \$5,160 (\$430 per month for 12 payments)
 - Grades 8-12: \$5,220 (\$435 per month for 12 payments)

Tuition is payable in one of the following ways: **Annually-** 1 payment due August 2018; **Semi-Annually-** 2 payments due August 2018 & January 2019; **12 Months-** 12 payments due June 2018 - May 2019; **9 Months-** 9 payments due August 2018 - April 2019. All tuition payments are due by the 15th of each month. The following discounts will apply if a family has 3 or more children in grades 1-12 living in the same household: 3rd child- \$240 discount per year/4th child- free tuition. All payments are due by the 15th of each month and all tuition accounts (seniors by May 5, 2019) must be cleared by May 15, 2019. **All families must create an account with our online tuition management system, Smart Tuition.** Please note that students will be suspended if tuition accounts are overdue.

Copies of birth certificates, a current and correct SC Immunization form, and a copy of their social security card must be on file in the school office before school starts.

- III. I agree to provide to the school a copy of a current SC Immunization Form, Birth Certificate, and Social Security Card.
- IV. All students must abide by the rules and regulations, including the dress code, i.e., uniforms, listed in the THA Handbook. This document, together with the Academy Handbook and all rules, regulations, and conditions in both, constitute the entire agreement and contract between the Academy, the student, and the parent(s). Should any portion of this document or the Academy Handbook fail to survive or be enforceable for any reason, the remaining terms shall survive and be enforceable. No oral modification of this document or the Academy Handbook shall be valid, except the same be in writing and signed by the parties to this print instant.
- V. I understand there will not be an opening for my child if he/she fails their present grade and that grade reaches capacity for next year.
- VI. The following rights and prerogatives shall be vested in the Academy:
 - 1. To determine the grade to which the child shall be assigned.
 - 2. To suspend or expel the child for any academic or disciplinary reason or cause, and in the event of such suspension or expulsion, the Academy shall be the sole judge of the sufficiency of such reason or cause.
 - 3. To administer reasonable corporal punishment.
 - 4. To require full payment of fees in the event of the withdrawal of the child from THA for any reason once he/she has been accepted.
 - 5. To refuse application based on criteria set by the Academy
 - 6. To reserve the right to search the students and their lockers at any time, or cause of allow law enforcement to do the same.
 - 7. If necessary, to require the parents to have the child tested by a psychiatrist or psychologist approved by the Academy.
 - 8. The school also reserves the right to search any vehicle entering or parked on school grounds.

DRESS CODE – 2017-2018*

Where to get uniforms:

- Uniform shirts must have the THA crest. They should be purchased from All Print Custom Tees (located at Jacob Smart Blvd.), Ridgeland or The Uniform Source (located in Savannah, GA).
- Fleece pullovers, t-shirts (approved for the 2017-2018 school year), hoodies, and sweatshirts must be purchased through our Booster Club.
- Uniform bottoms, shoes, and belts may be purchased at the vendor of your choice.
- Plaid options must be purchased at All Print Custom Tees or The Uniform Source in Savannah, GA.

Important information:

- We will designate special dress down or themed days throughout the year. Students and parents will be notified in advance.
- Uniforms may not have unapproved embroidery, glitter, frayed trim, etc.
- Uniforms may not be made of corduroy, stretchy, or clingy material. Uniforms must not be form-fitting, tight or too loose.
- Covering every concern with the dress and grooming in writing is impossible. Administrators can, at any time, send a student home or require that a student change their grooming or dress if they deem it inappropriate.

Remember:

- Students must arrive at school in uniform.
- All outerwear should be labeled for easy return if lost.
- Donated uniforms are available at no charge. They are located in the lobby near the library.

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| Shorts and Pants | All must be khaki or black - no cargo or extra pockets. Shorts must be knee length for boys and girls. Shorts and pants must be worn at the natural waistline. |
| Belts & Shirts | Belts must be worn (grades 5 and up). All uniform shirts must be tucked in for boys. Girls may wear shirts out if shirts fall slightly below the natural waist when arms are raised. |
| Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers, and Capris for Girls | Must be khaki or black (see plaid exception below) - no cargo or extra pockets. Shorts and skirts must be knee length with no splits. <i>A plaid option is available for Skirts (all girls), Jumpers (Grades K3-7), and skorts (Grades K3-4).</i> |
| Undershirts | Undershirts may be worn underneath uniform shirts, but must be a solid color - white, gray, or burgundy only. Undershirts may not have pictures or writing. Undershirts may have long or short sleeves. |
| Scarves | Scarves must be school colors - burgundy, gray, white, or black or a combination of the four colors. No other colors are allowed. |
| Sweater Vest | Burgundy with THA crest must have white collared shirt or white turtleneck underneath. |
| Sweaters for Girls | Burgundy, white, or gray button-up sweater with THA crest. Must be worn with uniform shirt and fall at or slightly below the natural waist. |
| Jacket (Optional) | Black squall parka from Land's End: Little Girls (Size 4-7) #415526-BP2; Big Girls (Size 7-16) #415527-BP2; Little Boys (Size 4-7) #415523-BP2; Big Boys (Size 8-20) #415524-BP3. THA crest must be added. Burgundy jackets ordered from Land's End in the past may still be worn. Burgundy zip up jacket/wind breaker with THA crest. Burgundy or gray fleece pull-over with THA crest. Burgundy V-neck wind shirt with THA crest. Lettermen Jackets (only approved for varsity athletes) - must be purchased from our athletic department. All jackets must be worn over uniform shirts. <u>Please Note: On extremely cold days the Administration may announce and approve the use of other outerwear.</u> |

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| Hoodies / Sweatshirts | Approved burgundy or gray hoodie or sweatshirt. If in doubt, check with the Administration. Uniform shirts must be worn underneath. Seniors may wear their Senior hoodies purchased from Jostens. |
| Shoes | All Grades: Closed toed/closed heel shoes only. Grades 5-12: Shoes should be tennis shoes, loafers, flat heel boots, etc. Students may not tuck pants in boots. Boots may not be worn with shorts. Grades K3-4: <u>Flat soles with closed toes/closed heels</u> (preferably tennis shoes due to safety and comfort on the playground). |
| Socks and Tights | Socks may be plain, solid colors of khaki, white, burgundy, black, or gray with the exception of a small brand logos of the same four colors (such as the Nike Swoosh/Under Armor Emblem/etc). Girls may wear plain, solid white or solid gray tights. |
| P.E. Uniform | Gym shorts, gym shoes, and THA approved t-shirt must be worn during upper school PE class. On the days when they are scheduled for PE, K3-7 grade students must wear gym shoes with approved uniform pants, shorts, or capris - they do not change clothes for PE. |
| Game Day Attire for Athletes | On game days, athletes may wear attire approved by the Administration in lieu of uniforms. Team members must wear the same shirt. |
| Hair | Boys may not have facial hair. There will be a \$2.00 charge if required to shave at school for razors. No sideburns below the middle of the ear. Boys' hair must be off the collar and no more than halfway down the ears. No punk or extreme layered haircuts. No colors or stripes in hair. Hair must be neatly groomed. |
| Hats | Students may not wear hats or visors at school. |
| Tattoos and Piercings | No visible body piercing, plugs, or tattoos. Girls may have modest ear piercings – not more than 2 and no bars. |
| Make-up Girls | Grades 7-12 may wear modest make-up. Grades K3-6 - no make-up. |

*Exceptions to dress code may be made if deemed necessary by a physician.

*Dress code is subject to change and will be updated in the 2018-2019 Student Handbook.

SMART TUITION GENERAL ENROLLMENT INSTRUCTIONS
